

ABOUT EFRI

The first school of higher education in Rijeka was established in 1627 by the Jesuits. However, the **Faculty of Economics in Rijeka (EFRI)** was founded in 1961, as a constituent member of the University of Zagreb. When the **University of Rijeka** was established in 1973, the Faculty became its member. Today it is one of its most important and active components, with more than 1,800 students.

The Faculty of Economics in Rijeka was among to first to introduce scientifically based contents, courses and research work in Croatia, founded on the theory and practice of Economic association and Integration of countries and their respective economies. The Faculty has signed agreements on collaboration with eminent foreign universities, both in the field of research and organization of joint conferences, student exchange, summer schools and other.

The Faculty carries out scientific and development research, especially programmes of strategic interest for the Republic of Croatia. All tasks of the Faculty are completed in accordance with the requirements of sustainable development of the economy and the social community in which it operates.

It performs undergraduate, graduate and various post-graduate study programmes in the field of Economy and Business Economy. Since 2011 it offers an International Business study programme taught in English (undergraduate and graduate studies).

The vision of EFRI encompasses integration into the European area of higher education and the European research area.

Lending support to the economy is achieved through drawing up useful educational programmes for the economy, joint research projects as well as widespread inclusion of student activities.

SUMMER SCHOOL

GENERAL INFORMATION

After a decade of successful Schools, the Faculty of Economics in Rijeka is organizing the **12th International Summer School - «International Environment and European Integration»**, which will be held **from July 3 to July 15, 2017**, in Rijeka.

The goal of the EFRI Summer School is to broaden the knowledge of students of economics, law, political sciences, administration and other related studies on the economic integration process in Europe, and to point out the advantages and challenges of economic integration in everyday life.

This programme will consist of lectures, workshops and assignments to be completed in groups with the support of academic supervisors. Due to its specific approach, the School will be appealing both to students with basic knowledge of EU matters and those who want to know more.

The Summer School is developed in cooperation with the local community, successful Croatian companies, domestic and foreign institutions. Lecturers will be from Croatian and European Universities, as well as other institutions.

Participants will be awarded with **6 ECTS credits**, after successful completion of the programme. The official language is **English**.
