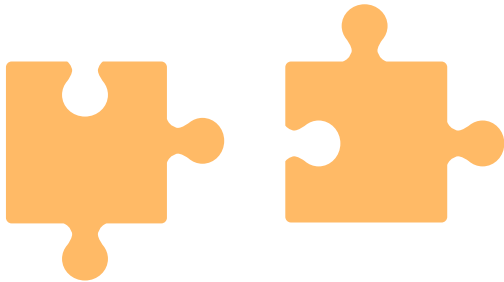

What is the SJIP?

The Sakae Japan Internship Program (SJIP) helps students who want to intern in Japan by matching them with companies looking for skilled foreign interns, and providing them with support throughout the application process and duration of their internship. Rather than charging students for internship program, we focus on helping interns build the skills necessary to work in an international environment, and at the same time help Japanese companies enter a more globalized era. Instead, our affiliated companies arrange and pay for the transportation and housing of their interns, and interns receive support from both their company and the Sakae Japan Internship Program for the entirety of their stay in Japan.

Process



Registration

In order to be matched with the company that best suits them and provides them with the best internship experience, potential applicants must submit our registration form, which can be found on our website. Once we have received your submission, we will reach out to you directly through either email or Skype and begin our support.



Skype Interview

To better understand which one of our partner company's internships would suit you best, we will set up a Skype interview. Interviews typically last between 30 minutes and an hour. The Skype interview is also a perfect time to ask any questions you may have about any part of the internship process.



Interview with Company

After the companies have received your information, they will begin the process of setting up a Skype interview with you. Depending on the company, the interview will be either in English, Japanese, or a combination of the two. Regardless, we will speak with you beforehand to give you some tips and tools for use in your interview. Special attention is given to those who are worried about having to interview in Japanese, and we work to make sure they are not caught off guard.
