


Terms and Conditions

The application letter must be accompanied by:

1. Detailed CV highlighting main topics of teaching experience.

2. A course syllabus proposal specifying the preferred language of instruction.

3. English or Spanish- and indicating the methodology that will be implemented (case studies desirable).
